Interview Questions:

- With whom do you most often hang after school? Who usually takes you home? Who is the first family member home after school?
- What day do you experience your most hectic after-school time? Create a time line of your after-school activities for each day of the week. What is the latest you have ever stayed at school and for what? What expectations do your parents have for you after school?
- When do you leave school? When do you usually get home? When do you go somewhere other than home after school? When do you usually have your evening meal? When do you usually go to bed?
- Where do you spend time between the last bell and leaving for home? Where is your favorite place to spend after-school time? Where do you spend most of your at-home, after-school time?
- Why would you consider after-school prime time? Tell me about the wisest investment of your after-school time?
- How do you make your decision as to how you will spend your after-school time? How many hours do you spend a week at school after the final bell rings? How do you manage your “me-time?”
